
Use KBART files to edit WorldCat knowledge base collections Class Handout

Search for collections, providers, or titles

Depending on the information that you have about your materials, you can search for collection, for provider, or for title

- Click Collection Manager
- Under Data Type, select:
 - Collection
 - Title
 - Can search OCLC number, ISBN number of the title, or ISSN of the title
 - Provider
 - Activity History
 - Data Sync Collection
- Option to leave the search box empty and limit search by Scope
 - My Selected Collections—the search will return results with your library's collections
 - All Collections—the search will return results from the global WorldCat knowledge base and any collections your library has created.
 - Not Selected Collections—the search will return results with collections your library did not create or select
- Use Filter by... to refine search results



Select and edit knowledge base collections with KBART file


1. Download KBART file

- Under the collection search results, click the desired collection to open it
- Click Collection Actions menu
- Select Download titles in this Collection

 Scope = Available titles in collection, OR My Selected Titles
- Click Download
- Save file to edit later or open file to edit in a spreadsheet program







2. Edit titles in a spreadsheet program (preferably EXCEL)

- Global vs. Local edits
 - o Global changes made to a global field are applicable to all libraries (e.g., Title Name)
 - Local changes made to a local field are only applicable to the editing library (e.g., coverage information)
 - More information about global vs. local fields can be found here: <u>Edit global collections</u> and titles
- Edit and delete titles to match your library-specific purchase or subscription
- Save file as a tab-delimited text file

3. Upload KBART file

In the desired collection:

- Click Collection Actions menu
- Select Upload Titles to this Collection

Scope = Update changes only, OR Replace all titles in collection

- Click Browse button and locate the file to upload
- Click Upload
 - You will see this message: Upload is being processed
- View the upload preview report



Approve or Discard upload

Add new knowledge base collections with KBART file

1: Create a new local collection

Under Collection Manager:

- Click Create a Collection
- Select Knowledge Base Collection
- Click Create

New collection screen displays (Required fields marked with red asterisk (*)

- Properties accordion
 - o Enter a Collection name
 - Use or change Collection ID (Note: needs to be unique)
 - Search for an existing Provider or Create a Provider
- Linking accordion
 - Enter Collection URL as appropriate



- Link scheme OCLC can create a link scheme for new knowledge base collection and add it here. Provide OCLC Support (<u>support@oclc.org</u>) with the following information:
 - Collection name, Collection ID, and Provider
 - Sample search from current provider to full-text
 - Username and password
- Click Create to add new collection

2: Add titles to a new collection with a KBART file

- Create a collection of titles in spreadsheet program. Each row contains information for one title
 - a) Add title using KBART formatting (see section below)
 - b) Use appropriate value in the ACTION field for each title:

Values	Description
raw	Use to tell the system that the title is added for the first time
autofill	Use the OCLC number to find the WorldCat record and populate title

- c) Save KBART file as a tab-delimited text (.txt) file type
- Upload KBART file of titles
 - a) Select Metadata
 - b) Expand Collection Manager
 - c) Search for the desired collection
 - d) Navigate to the collection screen
 - e) Click Collection Actions menu
 - f) Select Upload Titles to this Collection

Scope = Update changes only, OR Replace all titles in collection

- g) Click Browse button and locate the file to upload
- h) Click Upload
- i) You will see this message: Upload is being processed
- j) View the **upload preview** report



k) Approve or Discard upload

• Electronic books

Recommended values	Description of values
publication_title	Title of ebook
title_url	URL for ebook title
coverage_depth	Use "ebook" to indicate an electronic book format
print_identifier	ISBN for ebook title
online_identifier	eISBN for ebook title
oclc_entry_id	Title ID for each title in the collection
oclc_number	OCLC accession number, if available
ACTION	Use "raw" value to indicate data is added for the first time

coverage_depth	Use "print" or "other" to

Promote local knowledge base collections

Libraries can opt to promote a locally created collection to the global WorldCat knowledge base.

To promote a locally created collection:

- Under Collection Manager, search for the collection
- In the collection results screen, open the desired collection
- Click Collection Actions menu
- Select Promote Collection to Global Knowledge Base
- Provide a summary of changes. Click Continue
- Once request has been submitted, you will see the following message:



 Once the request is accepted and the collection promoted to a global collection, the collection ID and provider will change to:





Delete knowledge base collection and/or titles

6: Remove holdings from knowledge base collections

Depending on the changes with your library's electronic resources subscriptions, you may need to periodically remove holdings from an entire collection or individual selected titles in a collection.

To **Delete** an entire collection your library created:

- Under Collection Manager, search for the collection
- Search results screen displays
 - Identify the chosen collection
 - Under Selections, click Delete

To **Delete** individual titles in a locally-created collection:

- Under Collection Manager, search for the collection
- Search results screen displays
 - Identify the chosen collection
 - Click the collection name to display collection
 - Search for your chosen title(s)
 - Under Selections, click Delete Title
